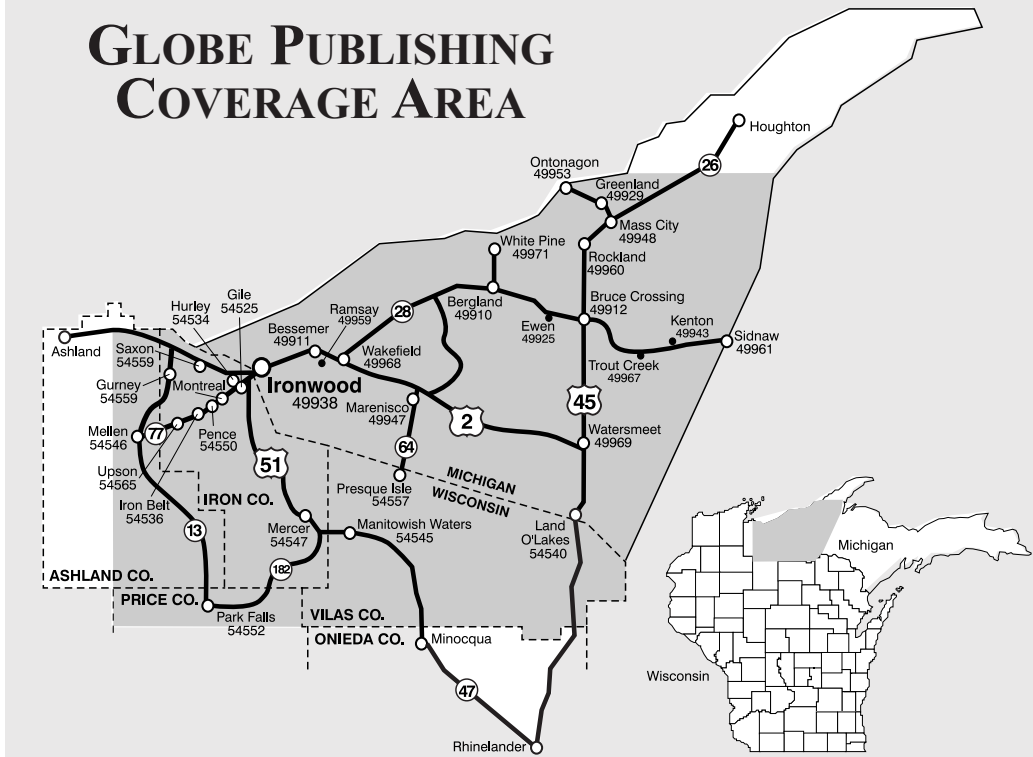

## Terms of Payment

### COMMISSION AND TERMS OF PAYMENT

## Circulation

## Policy and Copy Regulations

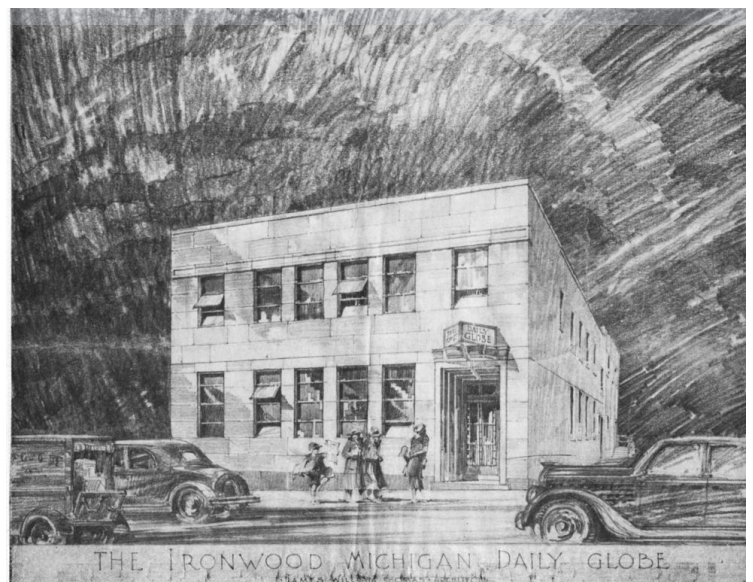
special publication. Advertiser will be charged for the incorrect insertion, and not charged for the corrected insertion.
